The limited use of data and GIS in the provision of health care has continued to hinder programme management, policy development and decision making in health. To curb this, the Health Informatics Governance and Data Analytics (HIGDA) Project in collaboration with the Ministry of Health is currently conducting the training of over 20 healthcare leaders and managers in the country on Data Analytics and GIS.
